The following indicates how GREENGUARD Certified products can be used to achieve National Green Building Standard points.

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.6 Hard Surface Flooring

- **Minimum of 85% of installed hard-surface flooring are certified to GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Children & Schools Certification Program**

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.7 Wall Coverings

- **Minimum of 85% of wall coverings are certified to GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Children & Schools Certification Program**

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.8.2 Architectural Coatings

- **Site-Applied interior products are certified to GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Children & Schools Certification Program**

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.9.2 Adhesives & Sealants

- **Minimum of 85% of wall coverings are certified to GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Children & Schools Certification Program**

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.10 Cabinets

- **Kitchen and Bath vanity cabinets are installed that are in accordance with GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Chemical Emissions from Building Materials, Finishes and Furnishings Test Method**

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.11.1 Insulation

- **Formaldehyde emissions of wall, ceiling, and floor insulation materials are certified to GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Children & Schools Certification Program**

### Indoor Environmental Quality 901.11.2 Insulation

- **Formaldehyde emissions of duct insulation materials are certified to GREENGUARD Environmental Institute's Children & Schools Certification Program**
